Re: Minimum Distance Separation (MDS) Update Information Session Invitation

To whom it may concern,

The Ontario Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs (OMAFRA) is pleased to provide this invitation to attend one of several upcoming information sessions for the revised Minimum Distance Separation (MDS) Document and accompanying AgriSuite software.

MDS is a land use planning tool developed by OMAFRA with the objective of minimizing potential nuisance odour complaints associated with livestock facilities and anaerobic digesters. This tool generates reciprocal setbacks between livestock facilities and sensitive land uses with the long-term goal of reducing land use conflicts.

Since its inception in the late 1970's, OMAFRA has committed to a regular review of MDS to ensure it:

- reflects current land use planning policies and practices;
- reflects current technology and trends in the livestock industry;
- continues to meet the needs of Ontario's agriculture and rural communities.

The latest review process began in December 2012 and culminated with an Environmental Registry (EBR) posting that concluded in May 2015. The comments received throughout the process were generally positive, with strong support from both agricultural and municipal stakeholders for the proposed changes. The revised MDS Document is scheduled for public release this fall with an official in-effect date of **March 1, 2017**.

How Do I Get a Copy of the New MDS Document?

Electronic (.PDF) copies of the revised MDS Document will be sent to all registrants shortly after the registration cut-off date, prior to the information session they are attending. Printed hardcopies of the MDS Document will not be available until <u>February 1, 2017</u>. After that date, printed hardcopies will be available at no cost from Service Ontario Publications.

The Provincial Policy Statement (PPS), 2014 requires that new land uses, including the creation of lots, and new or expanding livestock facilities comply with the minimum distance separation formulae. The *Planning Act* requires that municipal decisions regarding land use planning matters shall be consistent with the PPS (2014). Municipalities will therefore play an integral role in the implementation of the revised MDS Document through the inclusion of policies and provisions in their official plans and zoning by-laws. Where Do I Get a Copy of the New MDS Software?

The new MDS software (AgriSuite) will be available both in a web browser-based version, or a downloadable program. As of November 1, 2016 a link will be posted on OMAFRA's MDS webpage to access the software program, and we encourage you to do so before attending the information sessions. Please note that although the software will be available as of November 1, 2016, the official in-effect date for implementing setbacks calculated with this software is not until March 1, 2017.
